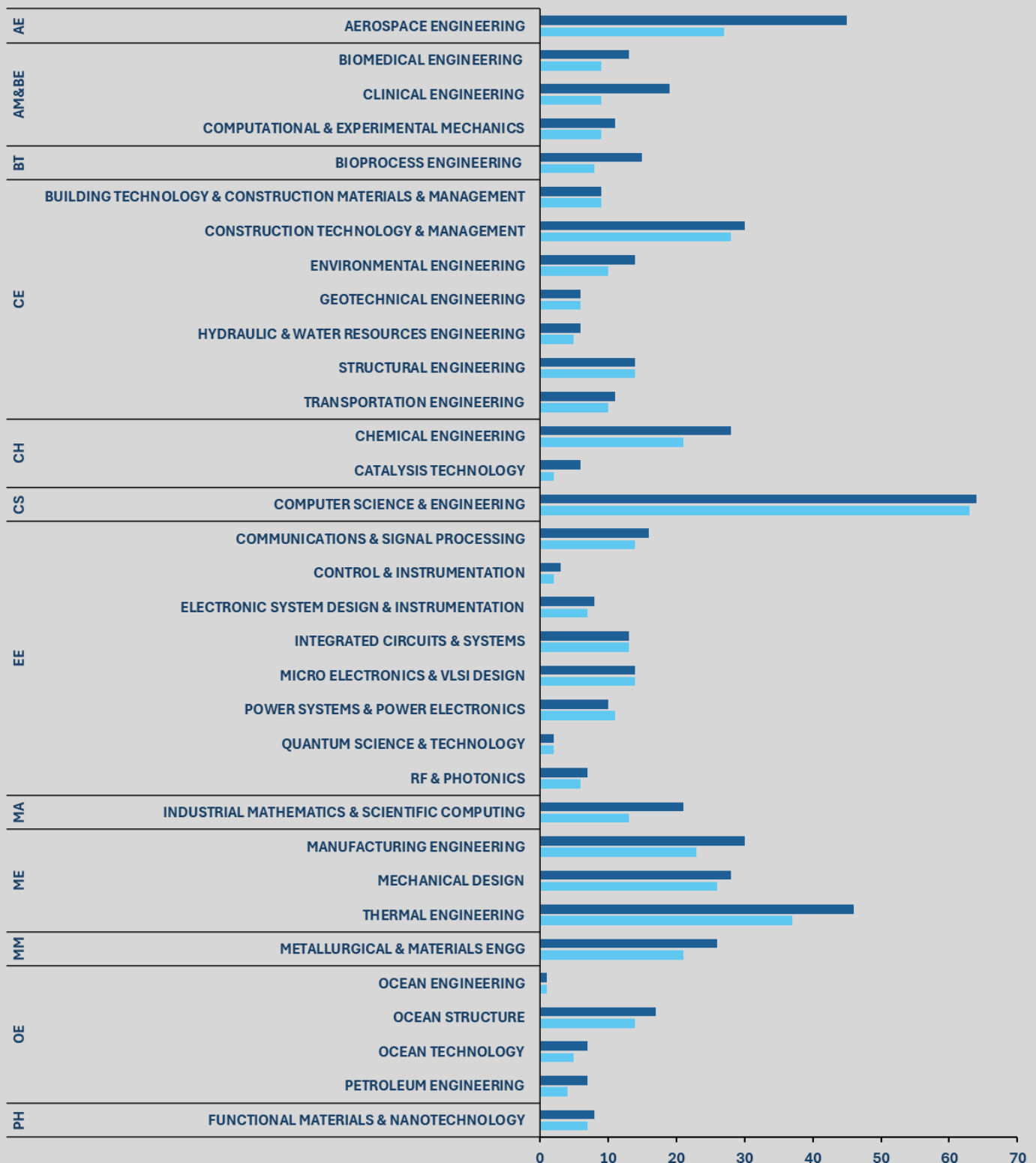
Interdisciplinary Dual Degree (IDDD)

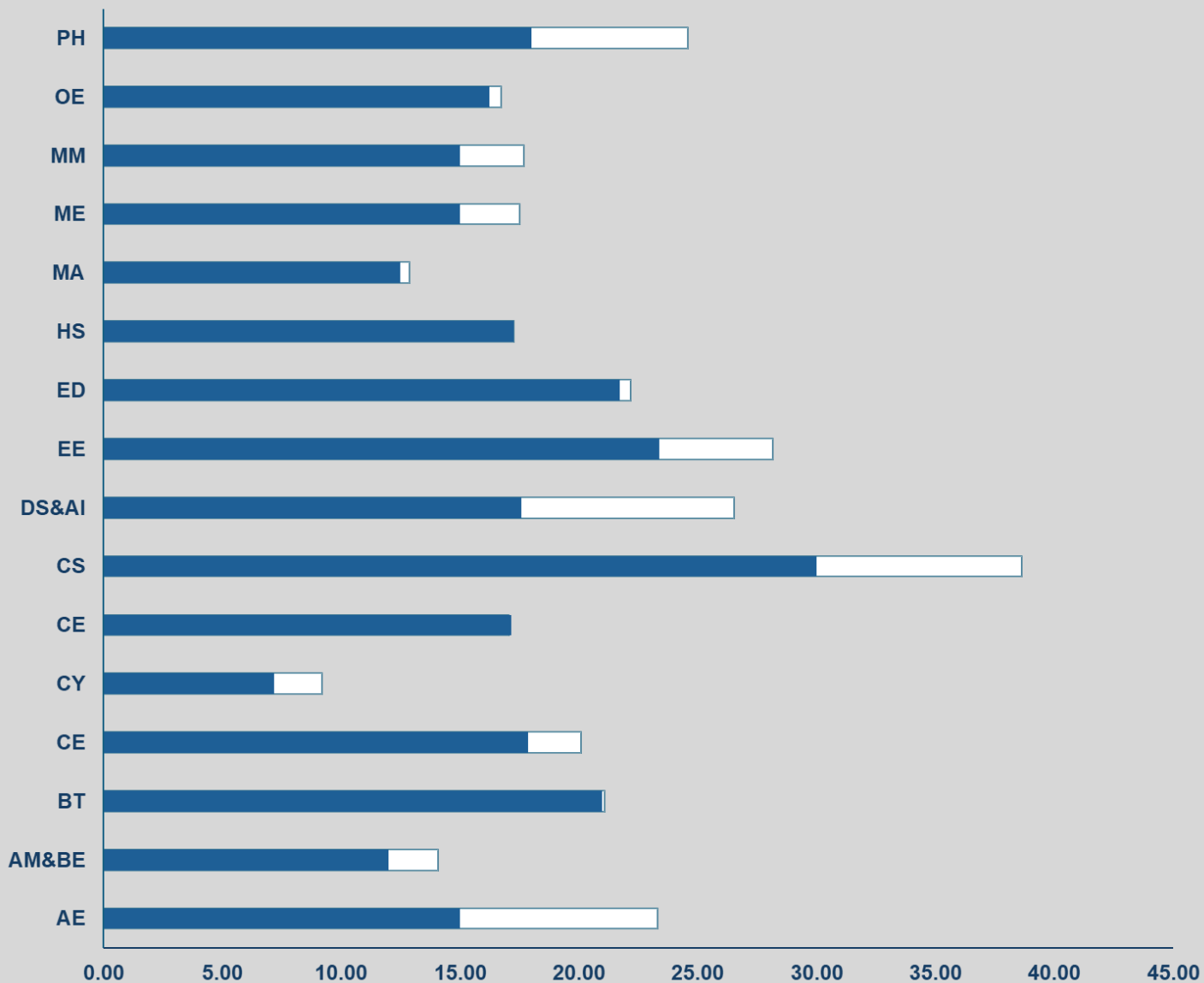
MTECH - SPECIALISATION WISE DATA

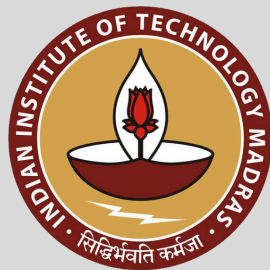
